HO-03_Work Plan – WorkGroups -(Groupings as Identified under-5-Year-WorkPlan Tasks)

The items/objectives below were drawn from the approved Work Plan to solicit volunteers to serve from among the Steering Committee members or senior staff member from their organizations.

#1. Programmatic Alignment & Strategic Engagement Work Group

- Objective 2.5 <u>Identify all key, relevant representatives</u> (individuals and organizations) of regional community of practice, <u>and actively</u> engage and solicit participation in identifying common species/habitat priorities /shared values
- **Objective 3.2** Identify, <u>prioritize</u>, and leverage existing opportunities to address these <u>communities of practices at ongoing meetings and events</u>
- **Objective 3.2** Identify, <u>prioritize and leverage opportunities</u> to communicate to their constituencies and plug into their <u>existing communications channels</u>
- **Objective 3.2** <u>Define how broad and deep our reach needs to be</u> (e.g., engaging county/municipal government and other civil society organizations)</u>
- Objective 4.1 Provide a <u>strategic assessment</u> that both identifies gaps in existing SC Member goals and actions, and offers the <u>greatest potential return on AppLCC</u> <u>investment</u>
- **Objective 4.2** <u>Define an engagement strategy</u> for each identified opportunity that includes recruitment, expectations, and a formal agreement of cooperation for use with identified entities
- Objective 4.7 Identify and integrate an ongoing process to help integrate the Steering Committee insights and reflection on organizational commitments to <u>refine the</u> <u>"Who/What/Why" of AppLCC and effectively communicating</u> what we are about
- **Objective 4.7** Design meetings, events, and virtual opportunities that ensure ongoing opportunities for Steering Committee Member sharing and dialogue
- **Objective 4.9** Identify and, through the work and decisions of the SC, <u>actively seek</u> <u>opportunities to align and engage regional</u> water, energy and land use planning entities

#2. Communications Work Group

- **Objective 3.3** <u>Host an Annual Stakeholder Meeting as a listening and feedback</u> <u>session</u> to reach/access the Steering Committee (ongoing) – Steering Committee with Staff support (GS/contractor support)
- **Objective 4.3** <u>Develop and implement a targeted communications campaign</u> that conveys brand awareness of AppLCC as the focal point for Appalachian landscape conservation
- **Objective 4.7** Design specific <u>communication strategy</u>, <u>processes</u>, <u>and tools</u> for <u>improving internal communication within Member organizations</u>
- **Objective 4.7** <u>Develop concise messaging</u> on Steering Committee identified topics for Member's use <u>with their legislators and key constituents</u>

#3. Science/Technical Data and Design Issue Work Group

- **Objective 1.2** Assist efforts to <u>assemble</u> each SC member organizations' <u>existing</u> <u>data protocols</u>, <u>data sharing contracts/agreements</u>, and <u>data sensitivity issues</u>
- **Objective 1.2** Develop a concise and transparent <u>data sharing policy</u> (defining "Whys" and "Hows" of data sharing) and submit to full Steering Committee for approval and adoption
- Objective 1.5 <u>Facilitate efforts to identify</u>, and access long-term <u>regional</u> <u>monitoring data sets</u> that would also to feed into the Science Centers efforts
- **Objective 2.8** Develop the <u>Charter to guide the "Integrated Planning Team"</u> of landscape-level conservation planners and modeling experts to serve as a standing Advisory Team to support the work of Staff and facilitation of consultation and integration of assessments and recommendations from the various COP

#4. Financial Oversight Work Group – [assigned Role of the Executive Sub-Committee]

- Objective 4.8 Establish a Finance Committee to monitor, review and make recommendations to the Steering Committee and Members regarding funding for AppLCC and AppLCC Member initiatives
- **Objective 4.8** Establish an annual review of AppLCC SC Member- and related Partner-funding support for Steering Committee consideration
- **Objective 4.8** Establish non-Federal funding mechanism to allow AppLCC (as a partnership organization) to seek and manage outside grants and funds

#5. Governance Work Group – [transition from 'Interim' – review of Charter, Organizational Structure, and Membership Requirements and Representation.]

- This Work Group helps to fulfill the Interim Governance/Charter which stipulated that Steering Committee and Charter to be finalized within 2-years of the date of adoption of Interim Charter (adopted September 2011.)
- Issues to review and make recommendations to be considered by the full Committee include: 1-agency/1-vote; frequency of calls/meetings; membership and organizational/sectoral representation; decision on absentee members/point-of-contact.
